### TWO PATHWAYS TO PARTNER WITH NO HUNGRY CHILD

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**Dear Sir/Madam,**

Thank you for your interest in partnering with No Hungry Child. We are delighted to see NGOs from across India coming forward to join our mission.

To accommodate organizations with different levels of readiness, we have introduced two application pathways.

#### **Option 1 – Regular Partnership Process**

This is the standard application process open to all eligible NGOs.

Applications close on 31st August 2026.

Each NGO will undergo our due diligence and project evaluation process. Based on the evaluation, eligible NGOs may be approved for partnership. The review and approval process is expected to take approximately 2–3 months.

Once approved, project implementation planning will begin. Funding support, wherever applicable, will be released phase-wise, subject to milestone completion, reporting requirements, and compliance.

As per our present schedule, the first phase of implementation is expected from April 2027, subject to approval.

## **Option 2 – Fast Track Pilot Programme (Limited Opportunity)**

We are selecting only 10 NGOs across India to participate in an accelerated pilot programme. The objective is to commence project implementation by 15th October 2026.

Eligibility – The NGO should:

- Be fully committed to implementing the project.
- Be willing to follow the No Hungry Child implementation framework.
- Be capable of investing ₹10,00,000 towards initial groundwork, infrastructure, mobilisation, staffing, and project readiness.

Please note: This investment is for creating the project infrastructure and field implementation. It is not a fee paid to No Hungry Child.

## **Important Dates**

**Last date to apply for the Pilot Programme: 31st August 2026**

Currently, only two pilot positions are available.

Interested NGOs are requested to visit our office on or before 31st August 2026 for a detailed discussion and evaluation. You should be willing to invest the amount on the same day. If this is not possible then go for Option 1.

Following successful evaluation, completion of documentation, and fulfilment of the programme requirements, eligible NGOs will receive priority processing under the Pilot Programme.

If your NGO is serious about building a sustainable child hunger intervention and is prepared to invest time, effort, and resources, we would be happy to explore a long-term partnership with you.

We look forward to working with committed organizations that share our vision: "No Child Should Go to Bed Hungry."
